## Factory Recommended Maintenance Schedule for 2023 and Older Subaru Vehicles

The following maintenance schedule is a simplified version of the manufacturer's existing recommendations

- 1) Blue ink represent the Factory Recommended Maintenance for severe conditions
- 2) Red ink represents additional maintenance items that the dealership recommends for your driving area or are not mentioned in the factory maintenance manual such as alignments, balancing and certain adjustments.
- 3) The chart on the left shows the correct maintenance package to use at your mileage. After 180,000 miles start over from the beginning.

For vehices using synthetic oil, Subaru recommends changing the oil every 6,000 miles. However, Garavel Subaru recommends changing synthetic oil no earlier than 6,000 miles, but no later than 7,500 miles; keeping in mind that the more major maintenance items that Subaru recommends are due every 15,000, 30,000 & 60,000 miles.
